## **Additional Permit Requirements**

- Applicant that has obtained right-of-way permit, must be registered with the City of New Ulm, bonded and insured according to New Ulm City Code Chapter 6.21.
- Applicant shall submit permit application with a site plan a minimum of 72 hours prior to non-emergency excavations. Applicant shall submit permit application for emergency work within two business days of when the work was performed.
- Applicant shall advise the City of any existing damage within the public right-of-way, prior to starting work. Applicant shall assume full responsibility for all costs associated with repairing City infrastructure including but not limited to: boulevards, sidewalk/trails, street or alley surfacing removed or damaged by applicant. Applicant shall meet all City requirements; corrective action may be taken by the City at the expense of the applicant for failure to meet these requirements. Future permits will be suspended or denied until a resolution is agreed upon by applicant and City.
- The 24-month warranty period will commence once project has had a final restoration inspection and meets the requirements set forth by the City Engineer.
- Applicant is responsible for any accidents or claims that may happen as a result of applicant's operations.
- Temporary (winter months) and permanent restoration of street/alley, sidewalk, and boulevard areas within the right-of-way or city-occupied or reserved easements must be within fourteen (14) days of the excavation work completed. Permanent restoration plans shall be submitted with permit application for temporary restorations during November 1st to April 1st.
- All connections made to any City of New Ulm utilities will require an inspection prior to backfilling. Contact Engineering Department at 507-359-8380 a minimum of 4 (four) business hours prior to the requested inspection.
- ❖ Gopher State One-Call locates must be completed prior to the start of work.
- From November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 1<sup>st</sup>, the only Right-of-Way permits considered will be for emergency situations unless otherwise approved by the City Engineer.
