

Highway 14/Highland Avenue

New Ulm

Project overview

MnDOT conducted a study of the Hwy 14/Highland Ave. intersection in New Ulm to analyze safety and traffic flow issues. With input from the City of New Ulm, local residents and businesses, the school district, and other project stakeholders, MnDOT arrived at a single lane roundabout design.

Summary of work

- Construct a single-lane roundabout at the intersection of Hwy 14 and Highland Ave.
- Construct new sidewalk and trail to connect existing locations
- Add lighting at the intersection

Traffic impacts

Traffic will be detoured during construction in 2024

- Improve bicycle and pedestrian accommodations



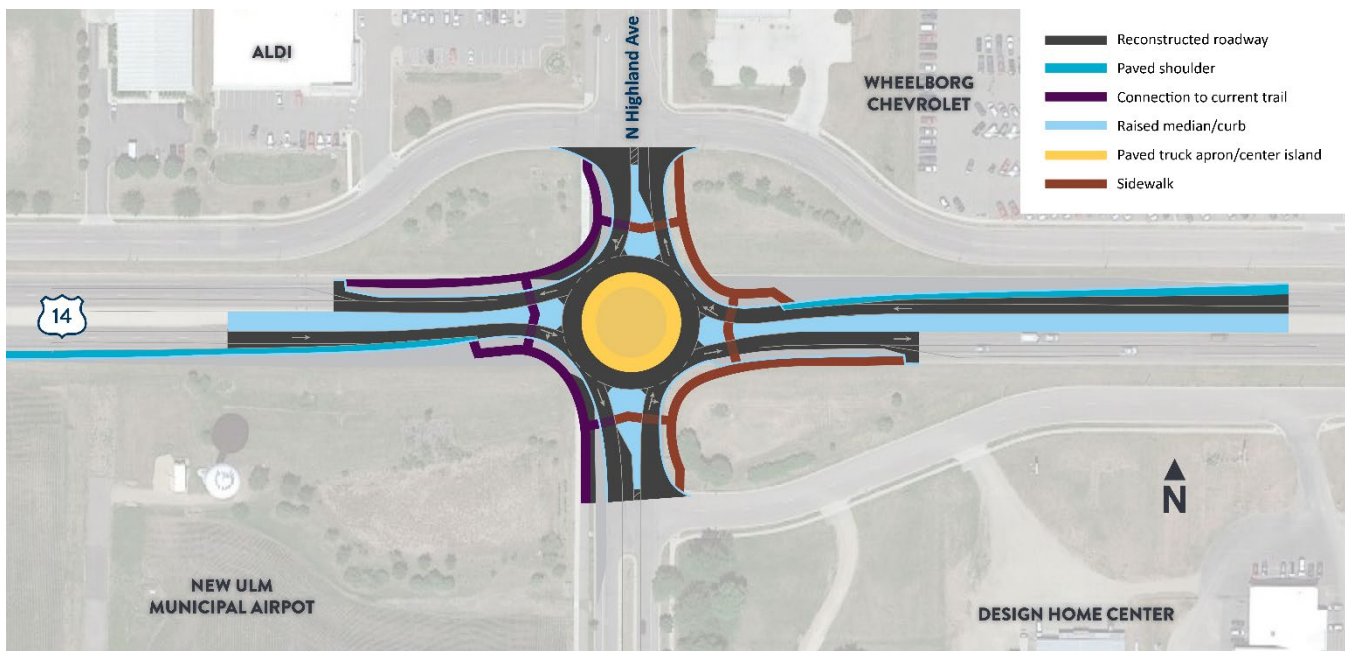
Cost
